

Education

Education metrics April - June 2025

Our goal is to strengthen Ethereum education across Latin America by focusing on fewer countries with deeper engagement, improving learning outcomes.

- Cities: 6 (Buenos Aires, Recife, Cochabamba, La Paz, Santa Cruz and San José)
- Countries: 4 (Argentina, Brazil, Bolivia and Costa Rica).
- University partners: 4
- Total students: 613
- Contributors to Ethereum OSS: 13
- **Graduates:** We expect 40% graduates. Some of these courses end at the end of July, others in mid-August, and others at the end of August.



Collaborations

We partnered with OnlyDust to connect our students with open source opportunities in the Ethereum ecosystem.

- We reinforced the value of hands-on learning through contributions to Ethereum projects: 96 students joined, and 13 made their first contribution.
- Through curated repositories and Spanish-language onboarding sessions, students learned how to contribute and build a public profile on GitHub.



Ministry of Education -Bs As City

The agreement with the Ministry of Education of the City of Buenos Aires continues to be a fundamental pillar for our Education department. Within the framework of the "Talento Tech" program, we have registered more than 360 young people over the age of 18 for our Ethereum Developer Pack course, which is free, virtual, and synchronous.

This partnership also allowed us to launch a new internship for young people from public secondary schools in the City of Buenos Aires. During this internship, a team of nearly **30 students** from diverse backgrounds (ICT, Developers, Marketing) will, with the help of our mentors, develop a prototype of a blockchain-based solution aimed at solving a school problem they had previously identified.



Events

Forum "Blockchain & Universities": we participated in the "Blockchain & Universities" Forum, organized by the Argentine Blockchain Foundation. We were part of the first panel, referring to the adoption of blockchain in Argentina and we also participated in a working table linked to blockchain in university management. More than 120 people and 20 universities of all over the country attended the forum. This reinforces our position as a benchmark for Ethereum in the university environment and allowed us to obtain +10 leads to initiate conversations for possible courses. 
We participated in "Mar del Blockchain", an event that brings together the blockchain community in Mar del Plata, Argentina. More than 130 people attended, and we received 18 pre-registrations for the Ethereum Developer Pack course, which we will be offering in partnership with the National University of Mar del Plata and will begin in late August or early September. 


#EsquentaETHLatam

Kipu Impact Support Program (KISP)

Peru:

dETHconomics is an educational program divided into specialized modules focused on Ethereum, Token Economy, Web3 Data Analysis, and, finally, the study of topics from the Robust Incentives Group.

The program is operated by DeFinomics Labs and APEECO (Peruvian Association of Economics Students). A pilot phase was developed in the last months of 2024, and Phase 2 took place in April 2025.

- +290 students enrolled in UETH.
- +280 student posts shared about their learning progress.
- 5 travel and accommodation scholarships awarded for Ethereum Lima Day.

In Q2, four grants were executed in Argentina, Brazil, Mexico, and Peru. Highlights include a blockchain workshop in Tres de Febrero to explore interest in the Ethereum Developer Pack, and community workshops in Morro dos Prazeres introducing Ethereum and connecting with local regenerative initiatives. In Mexico, the Latam Builders report was completed, offering regional insights.

In Peru, Edwin Fernández delivered Module 2 of dETHconomics, with over 290 students participating. These initiatives show the range of KISP: from education and research to grassroots activation.



Kipu Stakers metrics

We have led our grantees in the creation of two DVT clusters. These clusters are running on the Hoodi testnet.

This type of hands-on experience directly contributes to staking practices, accelerating technology adoption and confidence in its use.

- 8 grantees of "Jardineros de lo Infinito".
- 2 DVT Clusters.
- 8 cities connected (4 in each cluster).
